### **Print out your registration confirmation**


To guarantee that you get your badge quickly, it is important that you bring you registration confirmation. Here is a tutorial:

#### Your ID number

It's the 8 digits number that you can find on top of the delivery receipt that you received, as well as on your À Cœur Joie member card.

#### Step 1: sign into the intranet

Put this address in your search bar: <a href="http://intranet.choralies.org/">http://intranet.choralies.org/</a>. You should see this:



Write in your ID number [identifiant] and your password [mot de passe].

If you forgot your password, click on "j'ai oublié mon mot de passe..." and a new one will be sent to you by email.

• If you don't know your ID number, send an email to inscriptions@choralies.org. Then click on « Se connecter ».

You should see this:



The "mon profil" box should show "adhérent" (see image above).

#### Step 2: click the "Voir ma fiche adhérent" button (under the "adhérent" box)


#### Step 3: click on the "Rassemblement" tab



On the "Choralies 2022" line, click "Consulter". The registration summary will open.

CAREFUL: the summary (step 3) will not necessarily show all the services you paid for. They all appear on your delivery receipt (see step 5).

#### Step 4: [if necessary] pay for your registration




Click Paybox to pay online with your debit card.

Tick the line(s) of the workshop(s) that you have to pay and click "calculer le montant" (calculate the sum).

Then, click "paiement sécurisé paybox service" and you will be redirected to the secure online payment software.

#### Step 5: open your receipt and print it out



#### Click « Accusé de réception ».

#### You should see this:



#### Click « Accusé de réception xxxxxx.pdf ».



A PDF version of the receipt will open: you can now print it.

It is a summary of your registration to the Choralies that will be required upon your arrival at the festival.

### **Getting the workshops scores**

The Choralies respects copywriting laws. Copies of an edited and protected music score are strictly forbidden. Workshop scores can be bought, sometimes in booklets made specially for this edition, after we negotiated with the rights owners.

We recommend that you write your full name on all the scores you own and to bring a folder or a binder to keep them together.

**Before the festival**: the workshop scores can be bought on the Éditions' website: <a href="www.editionsacoeurjoie.fr">www.editionsacoeurjoie.fr</a>. The scores can be sent up until June 30<sup>th</sup>. You will be able to collect the orders made from the beginning of July at the reception on August 3<sup>rd</sup> or at the Éditions' booth during the festival, in the Choralies Village.

On August 3<sup>rd</sup> at the Espace Culturel exclusively upon presentation of your badge, after your registration with the Registration office.

You will only be able to acquire the scores for your workshops and, for the "1 jour 1 thème" (1 theme a day), the scores for all 8 days.

#### From August 4th, at the Choralies Village, 19 Quai Pasteur (see map on page 22)

(We will sell to everyone; scores are subject to availability).

You will find a wide choice of scores and collections for all choral formations, books, CDs as well as Choralies souvenirs.

For chorists that signed up for the "1 jour, 1 thème" workshops, our team will sell scores at the entrances of the workshops, half an hour before each rehearsal. These scores will also be available at the Choralies Village the day after (We will sell to everyone; scores are subject to availability).

### **Upon your arrival**

### Get your badge and your bag

### On Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2022

We will be expecting you at the Espace Culturel, near the Théâtre Antique on August 3<sup>rd</sup> between 10am and 6pm (you can park near the Chapelle Saint Quenin). Please bring your registration confirmation.

Once your registration is approved, we will give you your badge and, depending on the length of your stay, your festival folder (badge, Open Singing booklet for the 24<sup>th</sup> Choralies, programme...) at one of these counters:

Complete file counter ["dossier complet"]: everything is in order, perfect! Your badge will be ready before your arrival and you will spend less time at the reception. To make matters easier, please inform us now of any mistake there might be concerning your registration, and send us the missing documents and the payment for your registration as fast as possible.

**Incomplete file counter ["dossier incomplet"]**: go to this counter if your file is incomplete upon your arrival, if there are documents that you still need to give us or if you have not paid your registration balance yet.

#### Modifications counter ["Modifications"]:

Go to this counter if you want to change your registration. Modifications take time to be processed, so you should only go to this counter in case of an exceptional situation that need to be specifically taken care of.

**Groups counter ["groupes et collectifs"]**: each group supervisor (that was decided upon during registration) needs to go to the reception to complete the registration of each member and collect their folder. Each folder will be checked to make sure nothing is missing.

**Children's counter [Comptoir "Enfants"]**: the badges for children signed up individually to the children's workshops can be retrieved at this counter.

IMPORTANT: minors who are not accompanied by their parents for the Choralies and are under the responsibility of their grand-parents, their uncle, their aunt, friends... need to have a written parental consent. If it was not attached to the registration, you will need to bring a printed or written parental consent to the Choralies.



To ease the process and shorten the waiting time for everyone, check your situation and rectify it if needed now; make sure all the documents we are asking for were transmitted to us and that your registration is in order.

### From Thursday 4th August 2022

The registration office will be open every day from 8.30am to 6pm at the Choralies Village (see map on page 23). You can collect your badge and your Choralists file there. Make sure to bring your registration confirmation. If you have not gotten your workshop scores yet, they will be sold at the Éditions' shop in the Village (opening times: 10am to 6.15pm).

If you are a member of a group and you are registered for less than 8 days, your group supervisor will come collect your folders.

### Information specific to the volunteers

You asked to volunteer in a team. The team supervisor should have contacted you and informed you of the tasks that you will need to perform. Your commitment and the respect of the working rules that come with it guarantee an adequate organisation of the Choralies: thank you for your commitment!

You are asked, unless you are told otherwise by your team supervisor, to be on-site for dinner at place Burrus on August 2<sup>nd</sup> at 6.30pm at the latest.

Do not go to the Espace Culturel: your team supervisor is going to collect all of your registration documents for you (badge, Choralist file...).

If you signed up for the Camping option, you will be hosted at the Camping des Choralies, set up for this occasion on the terrain Baye.

Your team supervisor will give you other details specific to your role later on.

# Information specific to the children participating in the L22 - L23 and Atelier Loisirs Enfants

### The Junior afternoon (not accessible to established groups)

In addition to the workshops, you will be able to leave your children with our Junior team for Junior Afternoon, a kind of fun day-care centre, on specific days.

Registration will happen on-site and day-to-day upon presentation of a specific ticket (see below) to the staff, depending on availability.

Following the same rules as the adults, Junior Choralists will be attributed "Junior Afternoon" tickets that will allow them to participate in the "Junior Afternoon" activities, or to exchange them for a Daytime concert ticket at the ticket office.

These activities are not compulsory, but some organisation is needed for the team that supervises your children.

Upon reception of the badge; you will be given a provisional table of the planned presence or absence of your child to each afternoon activity. Potential changes need to be made the day before the activity at the latest, and changes made the morning of will not be accepted.

You will be able to fill out this table depending on the concerts you are planning on going to with or without your children, on your resting or your sight-seeing times...

#### What to plan for these activities (morning and afternoon)

- We ask that your write your child's name on every one of their belongings:
- A small backpack with a cap, sunscreen, sunglasses, if needed.
- Depending on the weather, a sweater, and rain clothes, and for the youngest, a complete second outfit in case something happens.
- · Sneakers,
- A water bottle (with your child's name written on it),
- No medicine in your backpack (not even arnica or aspirin!)
- No cell phones during the musical workshops or the animations: ask your children to turn them off during these times.

#### **Espace Juniors supervisor**

### **Example of a day as a Choralies child**

#### From 8.30am

Reception of the children (free time under Junior team's supervision)

Please make your presence known when you arrive.

#### 9am-12am

Musical workshop (mandatory participation) or children leisure workshop.

Please have your child bring a water bottle.

#### 12am-12.30am

Free time under Junior team's supervision

Parents or group supervisors come pick their children up.

#### 12am-1.30pm

Lunch with parents or group supervisors.

#### 1.30pm to 2pm

Reception of the children (free time under Junior team's supervision)

#### 2pm - 6pm

Entertainment and activities (participation is not mandatory). An afternoon snack will be provided. You will be given a schedule at the beginning of the festival.

#### 6pm - 6.30pm

Parents come pick up their children. Please let us know whether your child will be picked up by you or by someone else or if they can leave on their own.

#### 8.30pm

The Choralist badge allows children to attend the Théâtre Antique concerts, if they are accompanied by an adult.

CAREFUL!!! On August 4<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>: musical workshop from 2.15pm to 4.15pm (mandatory participation).

On these days, children that do not participate in the non-mandatory afternoon activities will be picked up by their parents or group supervisors between 4.15pm and 4.45pm. Entertainment will be provided for children that stay from 4.45pm to 6pm.

#### **IMPORTANT:**

A child will only be authorized to leave a workshop on his own if the parental consent provided during registration allows it clearly.



### Accessing the concerts as a Choralist

#### **Evenings at the Théâtre Antique**

Your badge gives you access to the evenings at the Théâtre Antique depending on the dates that appear on it (there are as many Théâtre evenings as workshop days). Children in possession of a badge or a ticket have to be accompanied by an adult in possession of a badge or a ticket.

Nota bene: a day at the Choralies starts with the Théâtre Antique evening that happened the day before. If your formula includes August 7<sup>th</sup> (which is an off evening for the Théâtre), you will be allowed to go to the next day's concert.

#### **Afternoon concerts**

Find out more about these concerts on the Choralies website: www.choralies.fr

Each person individually registered for the Choralies can attend a number of afternoon concerts for free. Free tickets go as follows:

- 8 days = 6 tickets
- 7 days = 4 tickets
- 5 or 6 days = 3 tickets
- 3 or 4 days = 2 tickets
- 1 or 2 days = 1 ticket
- Volunteers = 4 tickets (Accueil du Public and Régie de Scène volunteers are not concerned by this)

Tickets will be given to you in envelopes prepared by our team. Each will include a series of tickets depending on the number of days your stay will last. Each series include tickets with different dates, locations and musical styles selected out of all the programmed concerts. A list of the series and their detailed composition will be sent to you soon.

The list should allow you to choose the series you like best ahead of time and to save time when you will collect them. Be careful to select series that correspond to the number of tickets you are entitled to.

You will collect your ticket envelope upon presentation of your badge, **after your registration is approved**. We advise you to choose 2 or 3 different series in case your first choice is no longer available when you arrive. You will not be able to book series in advance.

Only Choralists who signed up individually and paid the normal Choralies rate are allowed to choose concerts from the series system. Choralists that are part of a group and that paid group rates will also get tickets for the afternoon concerts, at the festival's staff preference. The tickets will be given to the group's supervisor.

You will not be able to attend one of the concerts in your series? You want to attend a concert your series does not include? No worries! We organise a ticket market between Choralists that will hopefully allow you to get the ticket you want. This market will be open from August 5<sup>th</sup> at the Village ticket office.

### **Buying additional tickets**

The Choralies ticket office welcomes you at the Village every day for the length of the festival.

#### **Ticket rates for afternoon concerts**

Single price: €12 or €18 depending on the concerts

Groups singing during an afternoon concert will not be able to attend the concerts that are performed on the same afternoon as theirs.



The Choralies restaurant offers you varied menus that you can eat in a wide, shady area.

Opening hours of the restaurant:

- Breakfast from 7.15am to 8.30am
- Lunch from 11.45am to 1.30pm
- Dinner from 6.30pm to 7.45pm

The restaurant will welcome you from August 3<sup>rd</sup> for dinner, only if you have paid for this option beforehand (full board or half-board, for lunch or for dinner). As part of our efforts for the environment, participants who signed up for at least 3 days and who bought a restauration option will be given a **reusable cutlery kit** with their badge, after registration:

A case containing a knife-fork-spoon and a reusable cup; they will allow a significant reduction of trash at the end of each meal, compared to the disposable cutlery we used to use, which will only be given to short-stay participants (max. 2 days).

In case you lose or forget your kit, you will be able to buy a new one at the restaurant's entry for 5€.



We advise you to settle into the BAYE campsite as soon as you have collected your badge, and before 6pm.

### **Itinerary**

The camping is located at 380 Av. André Coudray, 84110 Vaison-la-Romaine The campsite will be signaled with windflags and a "camping" banner.

### Campers (including groups sleeping under collective tents)

Do not forget to bring everything you need to sleep (duvet, sleeping bag, sheets, pillows and your toiletry bag...). Collective tents do not have any electrical connection.

### **Camper vans and caravans**

There will be a provided space for camper vans near the collective tents campsite. You will have access to a chemical dump station.

#### Some reminders

You can check the campsite's rules and regulations online: <a href="https://choralies.fr/documents/">https://choralies.fr/documents/</a>

- Wearing your badge is compulsory to access the area.
- For everyone's safety and wellbeing, cooking and using gas lamps in tents and on the campsite are forbidden.
- Smoking and bringing alcohol onto the campsite are forbidden.
- Pets are not allowed.
- The tranquillity of the campsite is insured by a collective effort to be quiet. Please respect other people's sleep.
- Do not forget to bring your own covers (even in collective tents) because the temperature drops at night, even more so if the mistral (northern winds) blows.
- Bring flashlights, because the campsite does not have lights.
- Collective tents are mixed, except for children.
- You can charge up your phone in the "lieu de vie" tents. Socket plugs will be installed there.
- Once you are registered and settled in at the Choralists campsite, your meals will be served at the Choralies restaurant on place Burrus, depending on what options you subscribed to.

### "Passagers Chanteurs" residing in Saint-Paul-Trois-Châteaux:

Bring sheets, towels and a sleeping bag or a cover. Disposable pillows will be provided.

### Musical activities outside of workshops

### August 11th morning activities

The following workshops will perform their workshop concerts on the day and evening of August 10<sup>th</sup>: L03, L04, L06, L09, L12, L15, L17, L18, L22, et L23

We have a great activity in store for you on August 11<sup>th</sup> in the morning. We want to make a quality video of Open singing. We will meet on the stairs of the Théâtre Antique from 10 to 12am to video record your performance of the best works of Open Singing with Denis Thuillier and the musicians team.

There should be hundreds of you rallying for this. We are counting on your presence!

### Place Montfort: sing on the Podium!

The Vaison-la-Romaine team will install a podium to welcome groups who want to entertain the public from 6pm to 7pm on Place Montfort.

This podium is informal and open to all: choirs, groups, soloists, instrumentalists and other types of entertainers.

All you have to do is go up on stage! A sign-up board will be available at the Choralies restaurant.

### Access, security and rules

### Accessing the festival's premises

The different Choralies sites are reserved to people who are registered and wearing a badge that gives them access to what is planned with their registration or to people who have tickets to the shows. Only the chorists singing in a concert and who are not benefitting from any Choralies services are exempted from showing a badge at the entrance of the location in which they are performing.

We are required to impose the instructions of the anti-terrorist plan VIGIPIRATE given by the Ministère de l'Intérieur.

For your comfort and your safety, please make the workshop, concert and restaurant inspections easier (open your bags for checking, no knife or cutting objects in the restaurant or at the entrance of concerts.)

#### Sale

Illegal sale of any type of product is forbidden during the Choralies, on the premises of the event and their surroundings.

Merch will be sold at the Choralies Village. This area is the only one where commerce is allowed under French selling regulations on the festival's premises.

To avoid long waiting lines at the "dépôt" service, where you will be able to leave your merch, it is mandatory that you send it to the Éditions before July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

As an exception, choirs performing in the Choralies will be allowed to sell their CD and merch after their concert (only in this specific place and at this specific time.)

### **Copies**

On the Choralies premises as anywhere else, copying an edited and protected music score is strictly forbidden. À Cœur Joie respects the law and will strictly apply it. No copy will be tolerated in the workshops and the Choralies concerts, or in the entertainment places or the forum.

#### COVID

The state emergency on health is set to end on July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022. New rules might be put in place before then. We will apply the legal recommendations. We do not know what rules will apply to contact cases.

However, the past few months have shown that the evolution of the health crisis cannot be predicted. New variants appearing is unfortunately a possible scenario. Our event spreads across nine days and the high rates of transmissibility of the last variants compel us to be **responsible and proactive**.

We thank you in advance for your trust, your implication and your understanding concerning what we put in place to face the crisis.

#### What we did REVENIR ICI

Singers will gather 3 hours a day during workshops and we want to limit risks.

We plan on respecting the following health recommendations:

- A distance of one meter between all singers
- Ventilating the premises as much as possible

The workshop locations were selected for their dimensions and their ventilation capacities, and we set workshops' singers limits accordingly. We may use CO<sup>2</sup> measuring devices to satisfyingly air the rooms between each session.

These measures do not guarantee health safety, but they are an element of our collective strategy.

#### What you can do

The Choralies spread across a long time. We need to collectively reduce the risks of mass contamination. We ask you to please respect the following recommendations:

- **Preventive testing**: if all the participants test themselves the day before they leave for the Choralies, we could reduce the collective risk by identifying possible asymptomatic carriers.
- Please respect protective measures (wash and disinfect your hands, limit physical contact, etc.)
   during work times and fun times.
- You might meet friends you have not seen in a long time. Please avoid hugs and kisses.
- Those who want to can sing with their mask on.
- Remain courteous, respectful and reasonable in case you disagree with someone else's opinion on this health crisis that is affecting us all.

### In case you are showing symptoms

Out of solidarity with the other singers in your workshop, if you have a fever, a cough or a sore throat, wear a mask and abstain from participating in activities as you wait for a test or self-test result.

If your test comes back positive, and although we do not know yet what the confinement measures will be then, we invite you to:

- Withdraw from the workshop to avoid infecting the other participants;
- Inform people you have spent time with.

Cancelations for health reasons are not a valid reason for reimbursement. We invite you to check with your insurance if they can compensate you.


Direct coaches from the following train stations:

#### CAREFUL! August 9th farmer's market (place Burrus)

To avoid traffic jam and wasting time, we ask you to favour non-motorised transportation: walk, or ride a bike or a scooter. Tuesday is farmer's market day in Vaison and there will be more traffic, so please leave your vehicle on the designated parking lots.

All workshops and concerts are located in Vaison-la-Romaine and are within walking distance. They are all under a 20' walking distance from Place Burrus (Choralies restaurant).

As an example, here are the walking times between Place Burrus and

- La Cité scolaire: between 12' and 15'
- The nouveau gymnase: between 10' and 12'
- Le Centre À Cœur Joie Escapade: between 15' and 18'
- The Village Vacances: between 18' and 22'

These itineraries and the points of interest in Vaison-la-Romaine will be accessible via the geolocation of the Choralies app on your smartphone.

#### To Atelier L15 participants at the Village Vacances Léo Lagrange


